Two Years of Making First Generation Learners Become Job Ready:

In the year 2020, BFA signed an MOU with HCL Foundation with the aim to make more students job ready. With the closure of the second MOU, we at BFA were able to achieve satisfying results even amidst continuing pandemic scenario. As on 31st March, 2022, we were able to provide career counselling to 2792 students and vocational training to 146 youth. Among them 55 are successfully placed and 65 are still undergoing training. Our bouquet of course offerings also increased from 8 in MOU1 to 28 in MOU2 and so did the affiliated institutions. In MOU1 we had a tie up with 5 vocational institutions which have now increased to 11 in MOU2. We were also able to reach out to more schools for a larger impact. In MOU1 we gave career counselling to the students of just 3 inter colleges and now we have touched base with the students of 12 inter colleges. In our third year of partnership we aim to reach out to many more students and youth and help them become job ready.



BFA Admits Five New Bright Deserving Students for Better Education:

Last month, we had initiated the process of induction of bright deserving students in Class 5 & Class 6. With your help we were able to admit five new students in National Education Mission Public School (NEMP) and Noida Kanya Inter College (NKIC).
