We feel immense joy to share that due to the consistent efforts of our staff, volunteers and students from IMT Ghaziabad the attendance of aspiring women in our Adult Literacy Centre – Sankalp has positively increased. Previously only 7 to 8 women used to visit the centre regularly and now the numbers have doubled! Today 16 to 18 women are regularly coming to the centre with a desire to read and write. The old students have become the mentors for the new one making the atmosphere more constructive and inclusive. We are really looking forward to witness the transforming change in their lives.
