BFA provided Wall Hung Libraries, each containing 100 books, to the Nagaland Centre for Human Development and Information Technology (NCHD&IT). These libraries have been instrumental in establishing vibrant learning spaces in three Government schools.

Our Wall Hung Libraries supported NCHD&IT's project titled "Knowledge Hub," an activity-based learning in the Government schools targeting weaker students. The Centre reported remarkable improvements in student attendance and academic performance thanks to our WHLs. This feedback underscores the need for making WHLs available across the country. This year BFA has an ambitious target of distributing 400 WHLs free of cost to government schools in remote areas across the country.

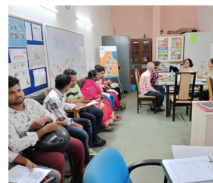
