25 Students Counsellled, Selected for Vocational Training

During April 2024, Books For All has selected 25 students for its Vocational Training Program. Following this, interested students shared their contact information. After their 12th-grade board exams, we reached out to interested and meritorious students to reintroduce the courses. Through detailed counselling and fulfillment of necessary procedures, we successfully selected 25 students for vocational courses in Paramedics, Cosmetology, Advanced Computers and Graphics and Food Processing. We're eager to enrol more students in the coming months and continue empowering them through vocational training.
