WHL Makes Its Way to Ladakh

We are pleased to announce that, for the first time, our Wall Hung Libraries (WHL) have been successfully installed in UT Ladakh BFA delivered WHLs to Chushul, Phayang, Drass and Khaldo, reaching five government schools in these remote locations. Additionally, in September, we broke our previous record by delivering 63 WHLs in one month across India, marking a significant achievement in our mission to promote reading in underserved areas.

For many years, we have been striving to send the WHL to Ladakh, and we are thrilled that our wish has finally been fulfilled. Given Ladakh's far-flung location, the Wall Hung Libraries (WHL) received a warm welcome from both the schools and local authorities. BFA is proud to celebrate this significant breakthrough in our mission to spread the joy of reading to remote regions.

BFA Delivers First set of Tactile Books to Isolated Community

For the first time, BFA successfully sent Tactile Books, consisting of pictures, shapes, maps etc that aid learning in visually impaired students, to two different institutions for the Visually impaired one in Chitrakoot, Uttar Pradesh, and another in Balliguda Codisha. Chitrakoot, known primarily for Chitrakoot Dham, is a remote and isolated area, while Balliguda is located in Odisha's Kandhamal district, home to the Kuii Tribal community. The Tactile Books for the visually impaired were generously funded by Ulverscroft Foundation, and these two locations were carefully chosen due to the significant need for educational resources in these underserved areas.
