Into this isolation, Books For All gifted a Wall Hung Library (WHL), a compact shelf of stories and learning that now hangs in the Primary School of the village. In a place where opportunity is hard to reach, this small library has become a doorway to imagination and hope. BFA's mission is simple but bold: take books to every corner of India, no matter how remote. Gobuk's WHL is proof that a few shelves can transform a community.

#### Today:

Priyanka Singh works at Cloudnine Hospital, Gurgaon, earns ₹35,000 a month, lives independently, and is self-funding a Bachelor of Physiotherapy. She's already won the hospital's Best Worker Award.

#### A Few Years Ago:

In 2020–21, she cleared NEET but her father's small shop income of ₹20,000 couldn't support medical college.

#### Turning Point:

Through a friend, Priyanka found Books For All, which sponsored her two-year Operation Theatre Technician diploma.

#### Step by Step:

She began at ₹10,000 in LVF Hospital, moved to ₹18,000 at Sarvodaya, then ₹20,000 at Motherland Hospital, each job building skills and confidence.

"I'm grateful to BFA for helping me stand on my feet," she says. Priyanka's rise shows how timely support can transform talent into independence.
