### **Drishti Eye Checkup Camp:** Clearer vision, brighter futures

Across four government schools, Drishti eye testing camps reached 715 children from Classes 1 to 8.

For 30 students, free spectacles opened the door to clearer vision and with it, better learning.

This initiative, carried out in partnership with Icare Eye Hospital, was a small step with a big impact: helping children see their world, and their future, more clearly.



### **Partnership with Project Aarohan**

**Kavita Prasad**, a Cupertino-based IT professional with over 30 years of experience in leading chip companies, felt a strong urge to give back after a demanding career. She founded **Project Aarohan**, a fully compliant 501(c) (3) nonprofit, as a platform for socially beneficial initiatives in India.

During her visit to India in late 2025, Kavita Ji explored NGOs in education and skilling with FCRA registration and was introduced to BfA.

After engaging with our team, she visited Sultanpur Library, interacted with students and teachers,

attended our annual convocation of vocational trainees, and joined a career counselling mela at NKIC. These experiences gave her confidence in our work.

Kavita Ji then committed to sponsoring Sultanpur Library, 10 WHLs, and 10 students for vocational training. On 6th December 2025, in a simple yet memorable ceremony, Sultanpur Library was renamed Project Aarohan Library. The event was graced by her children, who flew in from the US, along with close family and friends. Two WHLs donated by US supporters were also shipped to schools of their choice, marking personal celebrations with impact.

This partnership is a promising beginning to a long-term association, and we look forward to many village schoolchildren benefiting from this unique collaboration.
